ON THE DISTRIBUTION OF *ERSILIA MEDITERRANEA*
(MONTEROSATO, 1869), IN THE WESTERN MEDITERRANEAN
BASIN.**

KEY WORDS: Gastropoda, Eulimidae, *Ersilia mediterranea*, distribution.

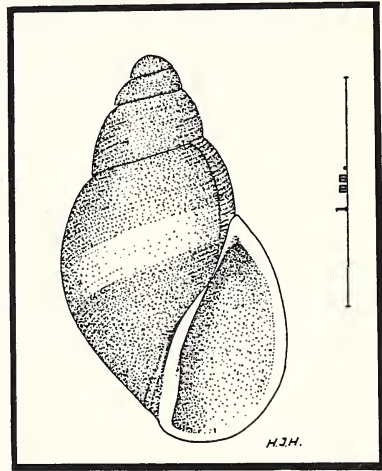


Fig. 1 - *Ersilia mediterranea* (MONTEROSATO, 1869) Italy, Venticari, VIII.1983.

In old volumes of *Bollettino Malacologico* we encountered the articles of GHISOTTI (1978), CECALUPO (1981), BABBI-RINALDI (1981) and MIETTO-QUAGGIOTTO (1983), about *Ersilia mediterranea* (fig. 1).

In our collection (H.) and in the collection of Dr. J.J. van Aartsen (A.), we found many other localities and it might be in the interest of the readers of *Bollettino* to quote them as we did in the following table.

GREECE: Gulf of Saronikos (A.) Gytheion, Peloponnesos (H.)

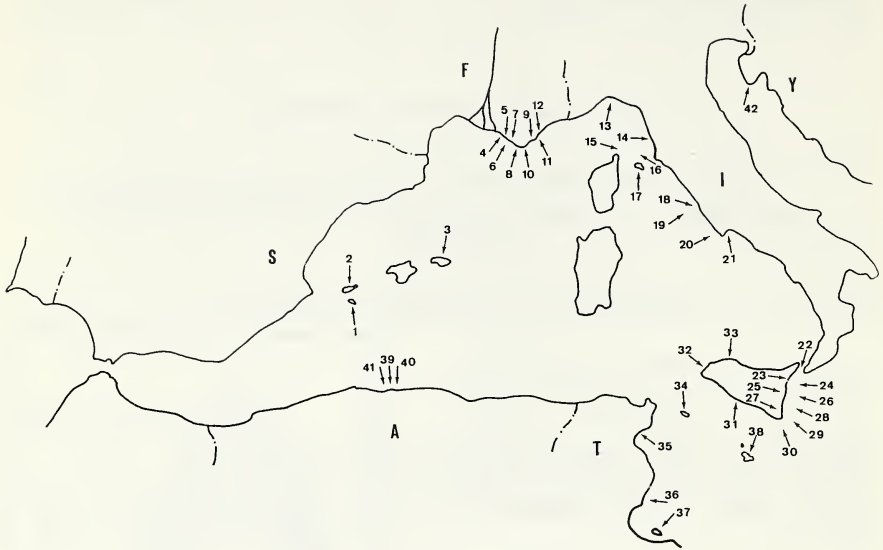
ISRAEL: Shiqmona (A.)
